Eclectic Components recognizes that we have a responsibility not to support or contribute to the violence and human rights violations associated with the mining of certain minerals in Central Africa including the Democratic Republic of the Congo, Angola, Burundi, the Central African Republic, The Republic of Congo, Uganda, Rwanda, South Sudan, Tanzania and Zambia.

Section 1502 of the 2010 Dodd-Frank Act requires companies to file an annual special disclosure with the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission indicating if their products include metals sourced from Central African regions in which Conflict Minerals are being produced.

Eclectic Components support the 2010 Dodd-Frank Act and the related U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission rule that promote transparency and consumer awareness regarding the use of Columbite-Tantalite (Tantalum), Cassiterite (Tin), Gold, Wolframite (Tungsten) and any derivatives from these minerals.

We are committed to conforming to this act and taking all action necessary to ensure that no Conflict Minerals (other than verifiable recycled material) are used in the manufacture of new components or product that we supply. We expect our suppliers to do the same.
